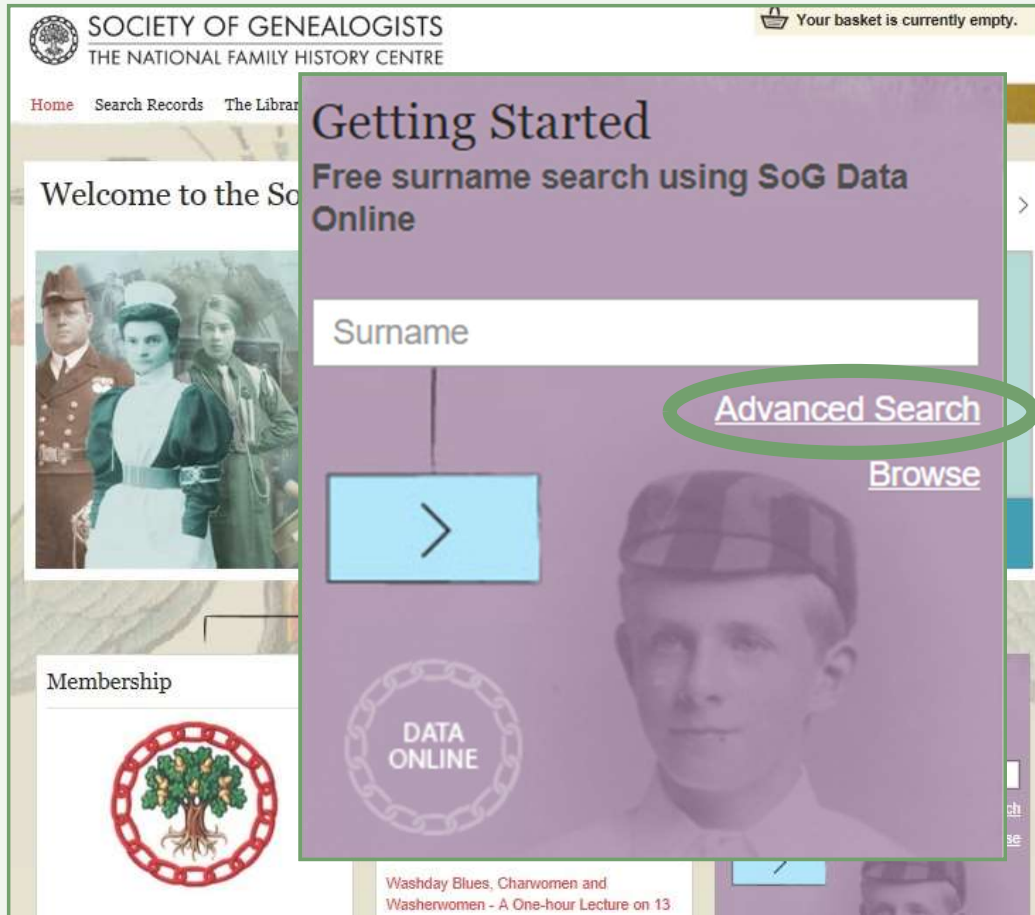


- Replaces CARN card
