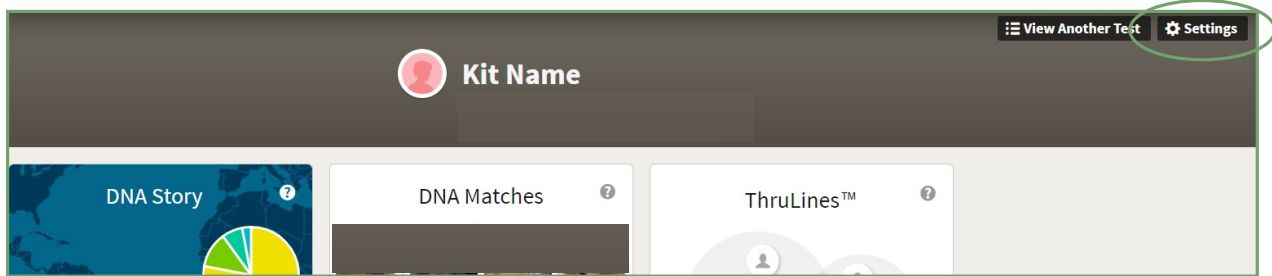


Hints & Tips – Sharing DNA Results at Ancestry

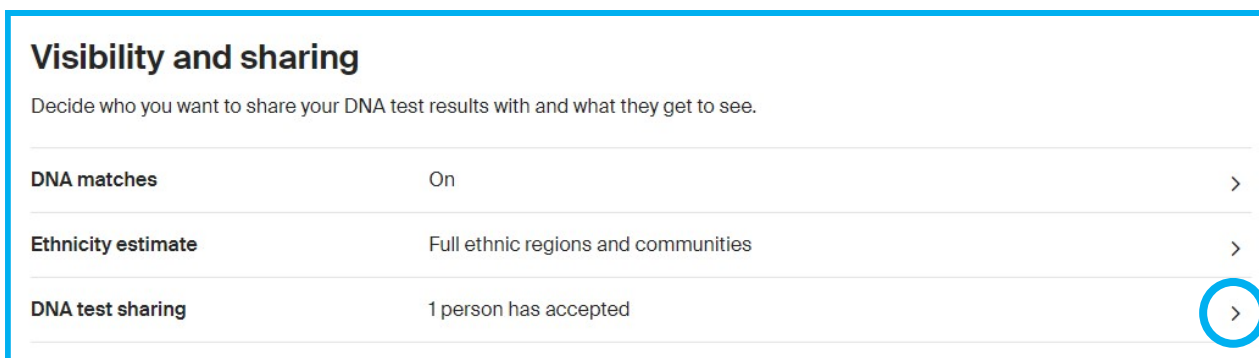
This 'Hint and Tips' document explains how to share your DNA results at Ancestry.

Go to the Ancestry DNA homepage for the kit you want to share with someone else.

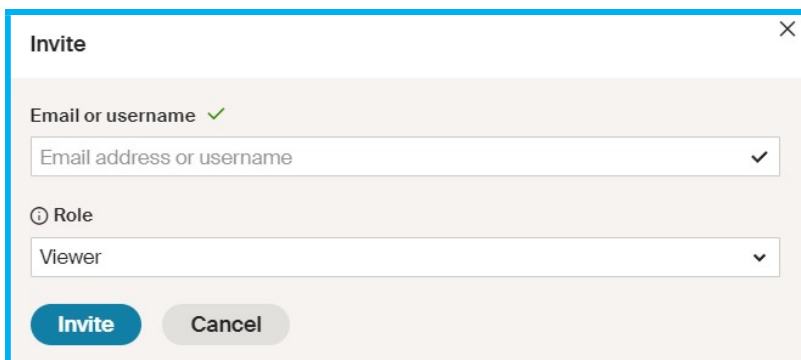


Click on **Settings** in top right corner (see green circle).

Scroll down to **Visibility and sharing** section and **DNA test sharing**. Click on the small arrow on the right.



Click on the blue **Invite** button. The following will appear – you may also have an option of 'Manager' in the drop-down list.



Type in the email address or Ancestry username of the person you would like to share your results with. Select from the drop-down **Role**. Use 'Collaborator' to allow the person to add notes and coloured dots to your matches. If you only want them to view the results use 'Viewer'. Do not give 'Manager' status. Then click **'Invite'**.

If at any time you want to remove someone's ability to view your results, follow the same process and you will see their name in a list under 'Accepted'. You can remove their rights by clicking the **'Remove'** button.
